While the people were waiting for their turn to consult with Dr. Flor, the gospel was first shared to them individually. We have learned that a lady who came to the medical mission passed away last February but we are comforted because we know that she heard the gospel and has accepted the Lord Jesus Christ as her savior.



We would like to conduct medical missions in other villages and I hope that you will include the needs in your prayers. We have spent about \$200 for the medicines and food for the volunteers in that medical mission but it was worth it because of the souls that got saved.
